The Town Council of the Town of Lake Hamilton will hold a Special Budget Public Hearing Meeting at 5:30 PM on TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 13, 2016, in the Council Chambers at Town Hall, 100 Smith Avenue, Lake Hamilton, FL 33851.

Mayor Wagner called the meeting to order at 5:30 PM.

Councilmember Roberson provided the invocation and all recited the Pledge.

SPECIAL MEETING BUSINESS

OPEN PUBLIC HEARING – Mayor Wagner opened the hearing at 5:32 and read the following for the record.

The name of the taxing authority is the Town of Lake Hamilton

The rolled back mileage rate is 8.0974

The final mileage rate to be adopted is 8.4276, which is 4.08% greater than the rolled back rate due to capital projects.

Public comments – Mayor Wagner asked for any public comments. There were none.

Motion by Kehoe/Roberson to Adopt Resolution 2016-13 adopting the final levying of Ad Valorem Taxes for fiscal year 2016-2017. Motion carried 4-0 on a roll call vote.
