PRECAUTIONARY BOIL WATER NOTICE

TO: RESIDENTS OF THE TOWN OF LAKE HAMILTON, ALL HOMES AND BUSINESSES FROM 7TH STREET TO US 17 THAT ARE SOUTH OF MAIN STREET.

THERE HAS BEEN A DISRUPTION OF WATER PRESSURE IN THE WATER MAINS OF THE TOWN DUE TO A SCHEDULED SERVICE. THEREFORE, WE HAVE ISSUED A PRECAUTIONARY BOIL WATER NOTICE. YOU SHOULD BOIL ANY WATER INTENDED FOR HUMAN CONSUMPTION, SUCH AS DRINKING AND BRUSHING YOUR TEETH

THIS "PRECAUTIONARY BOIL WATER NOTICE" WILL REMAIN IN EFFECT UNTIL THE BACTERIOLOGICAL SURVEY SHOWS THAT THE WATER IS SAFE TO DRINK.

We thank you for your continued patience as we work to improve the water lines throughout the Town.
